•	notify the Bonifatiuswerk of any events, which have a significant impact on the project especially if they appear to compromise the implementation of the project or its purse. This must be done immediately and without being requested.
•	check the display of the Bonifatiuswerk advertising banner.
•	have a collection for the Bonifatiuswerk as a symbol of solidarity in the parish / organtion.
•	refer to the sponsorship provided by the Bonifatiuswerk in reports / publications regarding the sponsored project, in particular during the respective final / inauguratio ceremonies
•	affix the acrylic glass plaque that is provided free of charge and reads "Sponsored by Bonifatiuswerk" in a clearly visible place upon completion of the project.
•	submit a final report including photos, an overview of the costs brought to account a the final funding once the project has been completed.
