

Exemplary Project Agreement for “Building Grants”

between

Recipient of the grant

and the

Bonifatiuswerk der deutschen Katholiken e.V.

(Bonifatiuswerk of German Catholics – registered association)

The recipient of the grant is responsible for the purposeful and economical use of the subsidies. The subsidies must only be used for fulfilling the purpose specified in the grant letter. The application of the funds must be accounted for in detail. Subsidies, which are not required for the project implementation, must be returned once the project has been completed.

The recipient of the grant undertakes to...

- provide frequent information regarding the building progress and the current status of the measures, in particular with respect to important “milestones” (e.g. start, topping out ceremony etc.)
- notify the Bonifatiuswerk of any events, which have a significant impact on the project, especially if they appear to compromise the implementation of the project or its purpose. This must be done immediately and without being requested.
- check the display of the Bonifatiuswerk advertising banner.
- have a collection for the Bonifatiuswerk as a symbol of solidarity in the parish / organisation.
- refer to the sponsorship provided by the Bonifatiuswerk in reports / publications regarding the sponsored project, in particular during the respective final / inauguration ceremonies
- affix the acrylic glass plaque that is provided free of charge and reads “Sponsored by the Bonifatiuswerk” in a clearly visible place upon completion of the project.
- submit a final report including photos, an overview of the costs brought to account and the final funding once the project has been completed.
